MENS SOCCER (0-4-1, 2-5-2)

Wednesday, Walla Walla University (6-6) away.

This will be the third meeting with the Wolves from College Place. A year ago Walla Walla won 5-4 at their place and last month the Knights were victorious 2-1 at home.

Saturday, Columbia Basin (2-3-0, 2-4-1) home.

The Knights and Hawks have battled since 1998 and this will be their 24th match.

The Black & Silver hold the upper hand in the series with a record of 12-8-3 and are 8-3-2 on their home turf.

CBC, third in the East Region, has lost their last two matches and WVC their last three.

Last fall the two squads tied 1-1 in Wenatchee.

WOMENS SOCCER (1-4-0, 2-6-0)

The key to the ladies success so far has been to whitewash the opposition. Both of the team's wins have been by 1-0 scores. The opponent scored in the other six and WVC lost them all.

Wednesday, Yakima Valley (4-1-0, 6-2-1) home.

The Yaks come to town today with a 3-game win streak and in fourth place in the East Region.

A year ago YVC topped WVC 7-1 on Mike Hollis Field.

After eight matches the series between the Knights and Yaks is even at 3-3-2. At home WVC is up 2-1-1.

Saturday, Columbia Basin (4-0-1, 6-0-1) home.

The Hawks haven't lost a match all fall and are third in the standings.

This will be the 30th meeting with CBC and the Pasco school leads the series 20-7-2 and is 9-4-1 in Wenatchee.

Columbia Basin has won five straight in the series including a 5-1 victory in Wenatchee last fall.
