VOLLEYBALL

Blue Mountain (6-0, 24-3) away Wednesday.

It's number 1 vs. number 3 in a showdown for top placing in the East Region. It's undefeated Blue Mountain in the top spot vs. 4-1 Wenatchee Valley...Spokane at 5-1 is in between. The first nine times the Knights played the Timberwolves, the victor in each occasion was the outfit on 5th Street. But things changed last fall. The first time WVC won, but the next two it was BMCC. In Smith Gym the Knights are 3-0 against the Timberwolves.

Treasure Valley (1-5, 11-14) away Thursday.

The competition with the Chukars will complete the Knights annual 2-day "south of the border" swing. TVCC is sixth in the standings and has been on the losing end of five consecutive matches. Past Knight vs. Chukar matches have been strictly decided on whose court was being used...WVC 3-0 in their gym and TVCC 3-0 in theirs. Once they played on a neutral court and Treasure Valley won.

WOMENS SOCCER

Spokane (4-0-1, 7-0-1) away Wednesday.

The Inland Empire squad has yet to lose a match, league or non-league. And they basically have had the same success against the Knights through the years in rolling to a 20-5-1 record. In fact since 2002 the Black & Silver has managed but one win in 16 outings. Last fall WVC was stopped 5-0 and 7-0.

Treasure Valley (1-3-1, 2-6-2) home Saturday.

After winning two of their first three matches, Wenatchee Valley has dropped four straight. But their Saturday foe from the Beaver State lost seven in a row until finally upending Skagit Valley Saturday. The Knights will be out to break a 6-match losing streak to TVCC and improve on their 2-12-2 record vs. the Chukars.

MENS SOCCER

Spokane (3-1-1, 6-3-1) away Wednesday.

The Sasquatch has been the Knights most frequent opponent since WVC started soccer in 1996. The two schools have met 27 times with the one further to the east prevailing 18-6-3. Spokane begins the week tied with Treasure Valley for third in the East Region. The Knights are fifth. A year ago the two teams tied 1-1 in Wenatchee and Spokane pulled out a 3-2 win on their field.

Treasure Valley (3-1-1, 4-4-2) home Saturday.

The Chukars are 4-1-1 in their past six contests (league and non-league), and as mentioned above, tied with Spokane for third in league play. The last three times the Knights have faced the outfit from Ontario, WVC has surrendered four goals in each match and lost them all. But overall Wenatchee Valley leads the series 9-5-2 and is 5-3-1 at home.
