

Knights go 38-9, claim 5th straight Eastern Region Championship



The 2010 Knights fast-pitch team put together a remarkable season and brought home the program's fifth straight championship title. They finished the year ranked #3 in the NWAACC coaches' poll and the 38-9 record is the highest winning percentage in the 25 years of the Wenatchee Valley College program.

If you were lucky enough to watch this team play this year you saw yourself how talented and fun-loving they were. Here are some numbers that tell the story of their success:

- Knights players combined for 464 hits this season while giving up only 146.
- The team batting average was .369, opponents hit only .241.
- 331 times the Knights crossed the plate; those who played against us scored only 109 times.
- The team fielding percentage was a remarkable .953.
- The Knights pitching staff led the entire NWAACC with a team earned run average of a combined 1.72.
- 82 times this year Knight players stole bases successfully while the defense yielded only 11.
- Through the first 20 games of the season our record was 18-2, the best start in school history.
- We had winning streaks of 13 and 11 games at different points in the season.
- Our record in the Eastern Region this year was 23-5.

The unrelenting rain in Portland cut short the pursuit of an NWAACC tournament trophy but did not diminish the accomplishments of the 2010 season. The team played hard every day, demonstrated respect for each other and their opponents, continued the tradition of Knights fast pitch, and finished the season with no regrets.
