The Annual North Central Washington Career & Job Fair will be held at Wenatchee Valley College on Wednesday, April 15, 2009, from 10:00 am until 3:00 pm. The event is free to the public and will offer attendees an opportunity to visit with approximately 60 business representatives about career opportunities and job openings. The business community will be well represented from NCW and the Seattle area. Booths will be set up in Van Tassel Center which is located in the center of the Wenatchee Valley College campus. Reviewers will be available to look over participants' resumés and make suggestions to improve them.

These seminars will take place in the Campus Theatre in Wells Hall. The resumé review and seminars will be coordinated by the Apple Valley Human Resources Association (AVHRA) members.

Recipients will have a clearly defined education-to-career pathway. Application is by the standard WVC application process and the deadline for submission is February 15 for the following fall quarter.
