The Wenatchee Valley College Drafting Technology Certificate Program provides training for individuals seeking employment as drafting technicians for architects, construction companies, contractors, utilities and engineering firms.

Before entering the drafting technology program, students are strongly advised to complete one year of high school algebra or its equivalent. Prior to entry into the program, keyboarding and computer literacy are recommended. Course work in basic drawing or drafting is also beneficial before entering the program.
