Associate of Arts and Sciences Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA)

1. Transfer to the Elementary Education program at CWU with the Wenatchee Valley College Associate of Arts and Sciences-DTA. You can meet preadmission requirements towards your bachelor's degree while completing the requirements for the DTA.
2. Students may transfer a maximum of 135 total credits from regionally accredited four-year universities, including a maximum of 105 credits from regionally accredited community colleges.
3. CWU equivalencies are shown in *italics*. CWU Transfer Policies and Course Equivalencies can be found at www.cwu.edu/~regi/equivalencies/college_list.html.
4. Work with a Wenatchee Valley College faculty advisor to ensure proper course sequencing for the DTA and elementary education major.
5. Visit the CWU-Wenatchee Center early in your academic career.
6. A minimum 3.0 GPA in the last forty-five (45) credits is required with a minimum grade of C (2.0) in preadmission courses.
7. Apply for admission to CWU at www.applyweb.com/apply/cwu/index.html. If you are in the first 60 credits of your associate degree, we recommend you apply for dual admission. Find application and guidelines at www.cwu.edu/centers/dualadmission.html.
8. Pass all sections of the Washington Educator Skills Test - Basic (WEST-B) early in your sophomore year. Information on the WEST-B can be found at www.west.nesinc.com.
9. Apply to the Teacher Preparation Program (TPP) at CWU early in your sophomore year. Download and print TPP application at www.cwu.edu/~cert. Submit application, character and fitness supplement and fingerprint form to CWU-Wenatchee. Have two (2) letter of recommendation forms (available on line) sent directly to CWU - Wenatchee.
10. Submit official electronic transcripts to CWU-Ellensburg and a paper copy to CWU-Wenatchee. If you have not completed your degree or preadmission requirements, continue to submit official transcripts quarterly.

Bachelor of Arts in Education Elementary Education

1. The purchase of College Live Text software is a requirement for EDF 301 or EDF 301A. Students admitted into the Teacher Preparation Program are required to present a complete electronic portfolio demonstrating their content pedagogical and professional knowledge, skills, and disposition as a partial fulfillment of their graduation requirements.
2. Completion of a minor or second major is required when the major contains fewer than 60 credits.
3. A minimum 180 quarter credits is required for graduation.
4. No grade lower than a C in major or minor, required English composition courses, and foundation coursework, and no grade lower than a C- in basic and breadth coursework will be accepted for certification.
5. Additional graduation requirements include a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 for the last 45 graded credits, OR an overall (all colleges attended) cumulative grade-point average of 3.0; a GPA of at least 2.5 for major, minor and professional education sequence.
6. Student will be required to take the WEST-E examination prior to student teaching and pass each endorsement area prior to certification.

* For TESL minor, student must complete, or have already completed, one year of study in a foreign or second language or the equivalent (at either the high school or university level).
