To all to whom these presents shall come Greeting Knowye that I Michael Hindertler of the County of Butlett in the State of Kentucky for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty <sup>Pounds</sup> Current money of the State aforesaid to me in hand paid by Martin Hindertler the receipt whereof I do hereby Acknowledge. Have Granted Bargained Sold & into the actual possession of the said Martin Hindertler delivered one Waggon and Set of Plow Irons, and one set of Harrow teeth and two Cows, and four Yearlings, ten Sheep twenty four Bushels of Wheat two tun of Hay two Pair of Speers three feather Beds and furniture three Bed Steads One Sogon of Chains two Tables and Stand three Iron Pots two Dutch Ovens. and all the pewter and tin ware, and other furniture One pair of Stillands three Ox's Three Stattons four hogs One thousand Weight of Bacon two spinning wheels One big wheel four tubs four Buckets One Grid Iron and frying Pan, One Skillet One Cutting Box, and the plantation whereon I now live on. and all the advantages thereunto belonging One looking glass and two flat Irons one hand saw One Drawing Knif and augers One black Reel which said property I do by these presents bind myself my heirs to the said Martin Hindertler his heirs & assigns to warrant and forever defend against all manner of persons whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1801.
