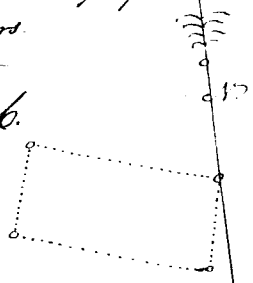

In obedience to an order of the Spencer County Court we met on the
31st day of October at the late residence of Christopher Suto Deed
and allotted the Widow Christene Suto her Dower in the Lands of
said Deed as follows (to wit). Beginning at two Beach trees and running
thence N. 71° W. 151 poles to two Beach trees, thence S. 20° W. 71 1/2
poles to a stone in said Suto's line thence S. 70° E. 157 poles to a
stone in another of said Suto's land thence N. 20° E. 71 1/2 poles to
the beginning six and three quarters
which are submit to the honorable County Court
at witness our hands the 31st day of October 1826.
