


# Medical Assistant Prerequisite Checklist

## General Requirements

- High school diploma (or equivalent)
- Cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Complete all prerequisites with a C (2.0) or higher
- Attend or view an online Allied Health Information Session ([www.wvc.edu/alliedhealth](http://www.wvc.edu/alliedhealth))

## Prerequisites:

Check course descriptions because some courses have prerequisites. Start by taking the courses you placed into on the placement test. If you are a transfer student, talk to a College Navigator to determine which courses to take first (email [edplanning@wvc.edu](mailto:edplanning@wvc.edu)).

- One of the following:
  - BCT 100 Basic Computer Keyboarding (2 credits)
  - BCT 105 Computer Applications (5 credits)
  - Documentation of computer literacy in Microsoft Office
  - ENGL& 101 Composition: General (5 credits)
- One of the following:
  - ENGL 97 Composition: Paragraph or higher (5 credits)
  - One year of high school English
- One of the following:
  - Math 90 Basic Mathematics or higher (5 credits)
  - One year of high school algebra
  - Placement into Math 93 or higher
- One of the following:
  - PSYC& 100 General Psychology (5 credits)
  - PSYC& 200 Lifespan Psychology (5 credits)
- HLTH 123 Medical Terminology (3 credits)
- Current Basic First Aid card  
Taking HLTH 051 (1 credit), PEH 182 (5 credits), or NURS 100 (10 credits) will train you in Basic First Aid.
- Current Healthcare Provider CPR card  
Taking HLTH 051 (1 credit), PEH 182 (5 credits), or NURS 100 (10 credits) will train you in Healthcare Provider CPR.

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
