

Wenatchee Valley College Radiologic Technology Program Effectiveness Data

Program Completion Rate:

Defined by JRCERT as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length.

Defined by JRCERT as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

A description regarding the students not seeking active employment, as defined by JRCERT, is 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduation is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education.
