

Entiat High School – Running Start Equivalencies/Requirements

To qualify for Running Start, a student must be of junior standing. Running Start students must meet all EHS graduation requirements to receive a diploma from EHS. College credits transfer to EHS on a 5:1 ration. Five college credits equal one EHS credit. Students are required to check in with the school Dean of Students every quarter prior to registration at the college.

All coursework needed to fulfill Entiat High School graduation requirements **MUST** be complete by the end of the winter quarter to be eligible to participate in graduation.
