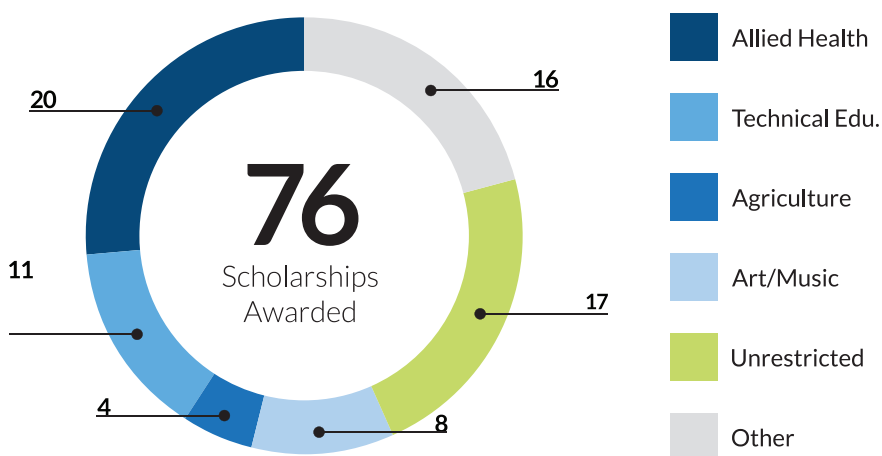

2022-2023 as of Fall 2022



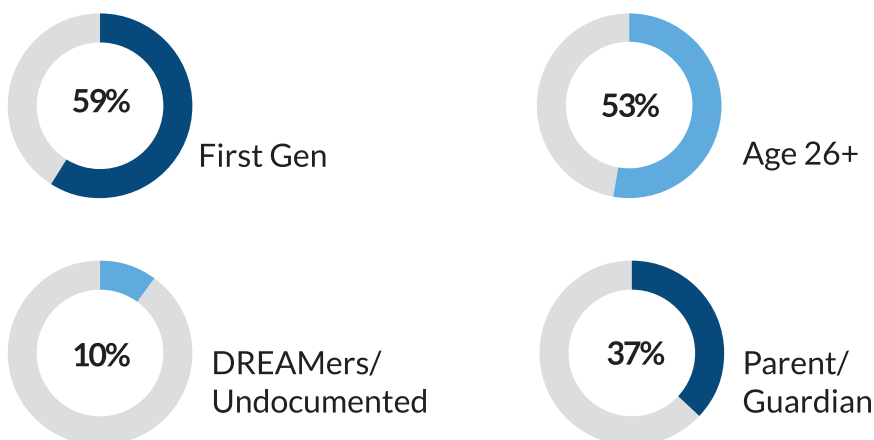
