Wells Hall Replacement

- Enhanced spaces where we deliver our most critical student support programs
- Classrooms optimized to support flexible learning with up-to-date technology
- A new “front door” to campus and a beautiful new conference facility
- Gathering spaces where students can convene, collaborate, and study

Center for Technical Education & Innovation

- A new center for our automotive technology program
- Facilities and tools for welding, environmental systems, and refrigeration tech programs
- Training facilities for sustainable agriculture, horticulture, and agricultural technology
- Flex space to respond to the future employment needs of our industry partners

Timeline and Goal

- Construction on the Wells Hall Replacement began in November 2019 and will be serving students by September 2021.
- The Center for Technical Innovation and Education is projected to begin in 2023 and open in 2025.
- The State of Washington will contribute funds toward the design and construction of these exciting new projects. However, state support alone is not enough.
- Over the next two years, we are seeking \$5 million in philanthropic support to match state funds and fulfill our vision for these new spaces.
