A gift from your estate can establish a legacy and support Wenatchee Valley College students. You can indicate a specific dollar amount, a percentage, or a tangible asset such as real estate. This sample language may help your attorney prepare or amend your trust or will.

For a Specific Amount

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to Wenatchee Valley College Foundation, Inc., a Washington nonprofit corporation in Wenatchee, the sum of _____ dollars (\$____) to be used for _____.

For a Percentage of Your Estate

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to Wenatchee Valley College Foundation, Inc., a Washington nonprofit corporation in Wenatchee, _____% of my adjusted gross estate as finally determined for federal and/or state estate tax purposes.

For Your Residual Estate

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to Wenatchee Valley College Foundation, Inc., a Washington nonprofit corporation in Wenatchee, to be used for _____.

For a Specific Asset

I hereby give, devise, and bequeath to Wenatchee Valley College Foundation, Inc., a Washington nonprofit corporation in Wenatchee, my _____ (e.g. life insurance policy, stocks or bonds, real estate, motorized vehicle, equipment, etc.).

The Wenatchee Valley College Foundation was incorporated in 1973 and is a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation organized under Washington law. It qualifies as a public charitable organization under Subsection 170 (b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Internal Revenue Code and is not a private foundation as described by the Tax Reform Act of 1969. The foundation is officially designated by the Washington State Board of Higher Education as qualified to receive and administer gifts for Wenatchee Valley College.
