Finance Dashboard

Highlights

- Morgan Stanley account was established to receive the McArthur estate gift of \$3M for scholarships.
- Draft audited financial statements were approved by the board on December 16, 2024 (<u>draft minutes</u>).
- Extension confirmation letter for 990 filing received from the IRS.
- Gift entry in donor database is lagging due to staff capacity constraints.
- Staff is steadily working through monthly reconciliations with foundation accountant's return to full-time.

Office Move

- ▶ The foundation will move to Knights Hall A on February 5, 2025
- An open house to introduce the new space will be scheduled later
- Why are we moving?
 - Easily located
 - Convenient parking for guests
 - Functional office space for all employees (currently only 4 workstations)
 - Dedicated conference room for meetings and small events
 - New "alumni lounge" to recognize graduates and display memorabilia
 - Consolidated storage space (currently spread across 6 locations)

Staffing

Foundation accountant Brenda Magaña-Galvan is back full-time.

Program Manager

- Replacement position for Ellora La Shier.
- Position will be updated and posted as Foundation Program Manager. Duties will include running scholarship application cycle, volunteer management, and events coordination.
- Goal: position posted by end of January, filled by April.


Admin Assistant 3

- Replacement position for Mireya Sanchez. Temporary contract with Mireya will expire January 31.
- Interviews have taken place. No one has been offered the position yet.

Year-End Appeal Goals

- 1. 8 board members record video testimonials for email marketing campaign. 6 board members recorded a video.
- 2. Raise \$15,000 for the Annual Fund (unrestricted) by 12/31/24. Estimated \$28,000 raised through all sources (online, catalogue, Give NCW).
- 3. Receive a donation from 15% of donors (58 donors) solicited through direct mail appeal. *Current estimate: 43*.
- 4. Gain 15 new donors (online or mail appeal). Current estimate: 7.
- 5. Secure matching gifts
 - 1. Board match gift: \$1,650
 - 2. Scholarship match gift: \$5,000
