Marcus Jaffe is a longtime resident of Central Washington and an alumnus of Wenatchee Valley College ('01). During his tenure at WVC, he was elected Executive Vice President of the student body - Notable for chairing the Student Activities Committee and lobbying the state legislature to maintain affordable tuition for community college students. He was awarded a scholarship for music and played in the "Universities Jazz Combo."

Marcus joined the Army in the Summer of 2001. He attended basic training and advanced individual training at Fort Leonard, MO earning the MOS of Motor Transport operator. Marcus' first assignment was with 1st Brigade, 25th Infantry Division. There he served in an armored formation as well as a Brigade Support Battalion. Marcus served in Operation Iraqi Freedom from 2004-2005, participating in both The Battle of Fallujah and Mosul. After active duty, Marcus then joined the 133 Army National Guard band as a bandsman (percussionist). He spent ten years as a military musician performing music across Washington State and Canada -- from small to major venues. In 2017, Marcus was commissioned as a Captain in the United States Army Reserve Medical Corps.

During his military duties Marcus worked through two different universities to achieve his goal of becoming a physical therapist. He spent three years finishing his bachelors in biology (exercise science minor) at Central Washington University in 2009. Marcus then went on to earn his Doctorate of Physical Therapy from the University of Washington in 2012. His time was notable there for being selected to participate in an international medical team's mission to Moldova for three weeks. This team's mission was to teach at local universities and perform bedside treatment demonstrations for the local therapists.

In 2016, Marcus was asked to develop a class for the Clinical Physiology Department at Central Washington University. This class's purpose was to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and actual patient care preparing students for the complex nature of patient care, clinical assessment, and appropriate interaction.

Marcus is now the Director of Rehabilitative Therapies at Kittitas Valley Healthcare in Ellensburg, Washington. He manages three different disciplines that provide care in all aspects of a critical access hospital - ranging from the top of Snoqualmie Pass to the Columbia River.

Marcus considers his greatest achievement (and joy) finding and marrying Jan, his wife of 19 years, and being the father to the next great American Superstar, Vienna (age 7).

Mauricio is a remarkable young man that truly embodies giving back and supporting the community in which helped him become who he is today. He is dedicated to serving his community and through sports, education and business partnerships. Mauricio is hard-working, enthusiastic and kind, and always has a smile on his face. I'm honored to know such a fine young man, and to nominate him for the WVC Distinguished Alumni Award.

Below is Mauricio's bio written in his own words. I asked him to write this for the nomination, because I did not know the history and extent of ALL of his community involvement.

I grew up in the Wenatchee valley and graduated from Eastmont high school. After graduating I attended WVC to continue my education and playing career for the Knights. During my time at WVC we were 2005 NWAC champions, we recently were named to the WVC Hall of Fame for that championship. After graduating from WVC, I transferred to Evergreen State College where I received an opportunity to play soccer and continue my education.

After Evergreen I spent several years in the Seattle area, playing and coaching soccer. I came back to the Wenatchee valley in 2016 to take a job with one of the biggest agricultural companies in WA State; Zirkle Fruit Company. I have been the Employee Relations and H2A Program Coordinator for the last seven years. In 2016 I was also an assistant coach for WVC men's soccer program, I was a volunteer assistant for three different seasons. I will be a volunteer coach for both men's and women's WVC programs this fall of 2023.

In 2020 during covid, I wanted to build a platform to be able to do more for our youth, especially student-athletes in the Wenatchee valley. In 2021 Wenatchee All Stars Football Club was born. We created a semi-professional soccer team in Wenatchee, which is something that we were missing. We needed a stage where student-athletes could showcase their talent and strike opportunities for scholarships and recruitment. I wanted to provide a service and outlet that wasn't offered to me when I was in High School or WVC. We've been able to connect around 12 players to higher education colleges around the nation, in just 2 short years of existence as a non-profit organization.

I've built soccer relationships around Washington State and the west coast, allowing me to send players out to different college programs for trials, visits, with the intention of becoming a student-athlete and continuing their playing career as well as opening up future career opportunities. This 2023, our All-Stars organization will be offering scholarship funds to various student-athletes wanting to continue their college education. Our soccer team rosters about 15 current WVC men's soccer players and 8 former WVC graduates/students. We've become partners with some amazing companies and institutions like Weinstein, Wenatchee Youth Soccer, Wenatchee School District, and other non-profits, to be able to provide our

players ways to give back to the youth and community by volunteering in many community events, visit various WSD elementary school to engage with young students, share our love for the game, and promote education by reading with them, participating in activities, and offering after school soccer programs.

The All Stars have seen lots of success in our short two years in operation. But we were missing something; a women's semi-professional team! We are working on bringing a women's program to the Wenatchee valley, to be able to offer our platform to all student-athletes and make it easier for all of us to continue to pursue our dreams.

We are working on structuring a partnership with Wenatchee Valley College to be able to direct prospect men/women student-athletes to WVC and help grow the student body as well as the level of competition for both WVC programs. Our college scholarship is intended to become an incentive offered by the All-Stars organization during our recruitment process, offering it primarily for student-athletes that are interested in becoming a WVC student-athlete.

As for my career outside of soccer, I am also a board member for Hand in Hand, an immigration services non-profit organization here in Wenatchee. With Zirkle Fruit Company, I am able to offer summer jobs to many of our soccer team players every summer.
