Course Titles: Interpersonal Communication; Public Speaking

Introduction:

The part-time instructor will be responsible for teaching one or more classes within the communication studies department beginning fall 2019 (September).

Responsibilities:

- Prepare or modify course content including syllabi, presentations and lessons.
- Utilize appropriately challenging coursework to help students realize their full potential as learners.
- Deliver information in an effective manner that supports the needs of diverse learners, including adults and Running Start students (dually-enrolled high school and college).
- Prepare adequately for class and submit required documents in a timely manner.
- Hold mutually convenient office hours based on number of credits taught.
- Address student concerns, comments, questions, and feedback respectfully.
- Participate in faculty meetings (as needed)
- Be a team player and support WVC's mission of providing individualized guidance towards transfer studies and career development in communication studies.
- Inform students of relevant events and opportunities for networking related to communication studies.

Qualifications:

- A master's degree in communication or a directly-related area is required. BA plus 24 graduate credit hours in subject may be accepted. College teaching experience is preferred.

Application Procedure:

We are looking for enthusiastic teachers who set high expectations but are eager to help students meet those expectations. Interested applicants must also have a master's degree in the field (or in a directly-related field). Experience teaching at the college level—particularly at the community college level—is preferred. Your cover letter should directly address the ways in which you meet these qualifications and expectations.

Interviews may include a teaching demonstration on a topic selected by the interview committee.
