- Official copies of AP test scores need to be submitted to the Admissions/Registration office for credit evaluation.
- A maximum of 10 AP credits can be applied to a distribution area on the Direct Transfer degree (DTA). There is a maximum of 5 credits that can be awarded in world languages.
- No more than 5 AP credits can be used to meet the writing skills requirement for a degree. AP credit will not be used for the writing requirement for advanced English composition
- Special Topics credit will be awarded in subject area.
- AP credit awarded a "P" grade, will not effect GPA, and will not apply to WVC residency requirements.
- Depending on the amount of other ACPL exam credit earned, a maximum of 30 credits can be used towards a WVC degree. For Workforce programs, ACPL credit is limited to 25% of total credits required for degree.
- For an AP test that does not appear on this list, WVC may grant a maximum of 5 elective credits for a score of 3 or higher.
- There is no fee for this evaluation.
