Can be enrolled in both chemistry and physics at the same time.</p> <p><u>Or</u> Enrolled in Calc 151 and have completed Chemistry 161-163 OR completed Physics 221-223 (or Physics 121-123) with "B" or better. Must have "A"s for lower math classes such as Math 141 or 142.</p> <p><u>Or</u> Enrolled in Calc 254 and have "A"s in lower math classes such as 141 or 142 .</p> <p><u>And</u> "A" in Biology 211 and Chemistry 121 required for any math tutor who has not taken the a Chemistry or Physics sequence. <b>Student must have at least a GPA of 3.5 or higher and have completed <u>AT LEAST</u> Math 99 and is currently enrolled in Math 141 AND a biology of cells, intro to chemistry or college physics class.</b></p>
