



WVC TRiO SSS Participant Application Student Support Services

WVC TRiO increases opportunities for success of first-generation and low income students who may have disabilities. In order to be considered for the TRiO Student Support Services Program you must meet the following eligibility requirements:

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Be a U.S. citizen or legal Permanent Resident; and
- 2. Have a high school diploma or GED certificate; and
- 3. Be accepted for enrollment or currently enrolled at Wenatchee Valley College in a college level program; **and**
- 4. Intend to transfer to a four year college to pursue a bachelor's degree; and
- 5. Not already have a degree from a four year college or university; and
- 6. Be a first generation college student (neither parent nor guardian has graduated from four year college or university) **OR** be low income (according to federal low income guidelines), **OR** have a documented disability and are registered with Access Services.
- *Refer to the Federal Low Income Guidelines Table below to determine if you are considered low income.

To Apply

- 1. Complete WVC admission application. Apply online at www.wvc.edu/apply
- 2. Complete a TRiO SSS application & short essay response
- 3. Submit a copy of the following documents to TRiO SSS:
 - □ WVC unofficial transcript.
 - ☐ If you are a permanent resident, attach a photocopy of your Alien ID card.
 - ☐ If you have attended *other* community colleges, include a copy of your unofficial transcripts.
 - ☐ FAFSA completion confirmation with EFC (expected family contribution). If you have not completed your FAFSA, attach a copy of your **income tax return documents**

Submit complete application to the TRiO SSS mail box located in Batjer Hall, Service Center:

Application and Notification

- 1) **Application Process:** It will take 1-2 weeks for TRiO to process your application. If there are spots open in TRiO, and your application progresses through the screening processes, the TRiO Program Assistant will contact you to inform you of your status and schedule an interview with a TRiO Completion Coach.
- 2) **Interview:** The interview lasts between ½ to a 1 hour and is conducted by a TRiO Completion Coach. This is an opportunity for TRiO to learn more about your educational and career goals and will help us determine if you will benefit from our services.
- 3) **TRiO Orientation:** If you successfully go through the interview and are accepted you will be schedule for your TRiO Orientation where you'll be officially inducted as a TRiO Participant and gain access to our services and resources.

Note: If we determine throughout any phase of the application process that you are not eligible for TRiO and/or there are no spots available, the TRiO Director will email you of your status.
