

TRIO SSS Transfer Mentor Description

The Transfer Mentor Program is designed for students who want to help, encourage, support, and guide TRIO SSS participants at WVC through the process of applying to and successfully transferring to a four-year institution. Transfer mentors play a vital role in facilitating the adjustment of new transfer students to a four-year institution.

Scope of Work:

- Communicate with assigned WVC TRIO SSS student(s) at least once per month (e.g., phone, texting, email, zoom, Facebook Messenger, etc.) for a minimum of 5 times for the school year.
- Answer questions about the transfer process. Provide academic guidance and resources to mentee(s).
- Respond to TRIO SSS staff and mentee within 1 business day.
- Report to supervising TRIO SSS staff member once per month via email.
- Document contacts via a spreadsheet.
- Complete an online orientation/training.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Current TRIO student and/or student who has experience working with students from underrepresented backgrounds (first generation, low-income, and/or students with disabilities).
- Be in good academic standing (2.5 GPA or above preferred).
- Enrolled at a four-year institution.
- Demonstrate strong interpersonal skills including strong oral and written communication.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude, self-motivation, and accountability.
